Effective Planning

Extensive planning takes place to ensure that residents of Chateau de Notre Dame will be protected in the event that a hurricane evacuation should take place. **When Chateau de Notre Dame calls for an evacuation, EVERYONE must leave the building. No one will be allowed to stay in their apartment once the building is evacuated.**

This brochure provides information for residents to refer to in the event of an evacuation. Please read through this carefully and be sure to ask any questions that you may have before the threat of an evacuation.

Your Help is important!

It is imperative that we have your assistance and cooperation in providing for our safety in a disaster. Please review the following and take all necessary steps to prepare yourself for an emergency:

- Review your own evacuation plans and make plans for a family member or friend to pick you up. This is the safest alternative.
- If you have no family to evacuate with, please let us know right away. Anyone who has no evacuation alternatives will be able to evacuate with the nursing home residents to Bunkie, LA.
- If you evacuate with Chateau, you will need to bring the following:
 1. Medications and medical supplies
 2. 5 days of clothing (including a sweater or jacket)
 3. ToiletriesA bed/cot and food/drinks will be supplied by Chateau.
- It is up to you to ensure that we have your most up to date contact information. Please let us know where you will be during an evacuation. An email address and an out-of-state contact number would be very helpful as well.

Necessities:

Chateau de Notre Dame evacuates 36 to 72 hours before a hurricane is expected to make land fall. In order for this evacuation to work, everyone must be prepared. A good way to be prepared is to make an evacuation bag. Your evacuation bag can be prepared and ready NOW with the following items:

- Flashlight
- A two week supply of medications
- 5 days worth of clothing
- Toiletries
- An evacuation plan
- Any other supplies that you need (medical, etc...)

Items needed for in-house evacuation:

- Food and snacks (enough for 7 days)**
- Plenty of bottled water**
- Make sure to fill your bathtubs with water for an in-house evacuation.

***An in-house evacuation means if we have bad weather and lose electricity.*

These items should be labeled and packed in your emergency bag, or at a minimum be easily accessible to pack up at a moments notice.

Being prepared can help ease the stress and anxiety of an evacuation!!!
